

## **Club Membership Charges 2008**

Over the last few months your club committee has been considering the fees that we charge for membership and participating in cricket matches and practice sessions. At the start of the process it was agreed that:

- We want to involve more people as members of the club. This includes parents, grandparents and all family members.
- All players get extremely good value for money.
- The collection of fees for junior fixtures and practice sessions is time consuming and problematic for parents and coaches.

The solution has been seen as a re-structuring of membership fees. Following the 2008 AGM club membership fees have been held at 2007 levels. However, members will now be charged a cricket fee to cover the cost of participating in fixtures and practice sessions.

For U11s the cricket fee has been set at £30 or £5 per month for the six months of the season. This is a total cost of just £45 for a summer of cricket under the supervision of the club's ever increasing band of qualified coaches. For most U11s this will be a cost reduction compared with 2007.

For all other categories of membership the cricket fee has been set at £60 or £10 per month for the six months of the season. All of the older age groups provide more opportunities for competitive cricket and the AGM agreed that this still offers excellent value for money

We are delighted that a new Family membership category has been agreed by the AGM. This covers all family members for a membership fee of £50 and a single cricket fee of £60 regardless of the number of family members. The single cricket fee will also apply when brothers and sisters are individual junior members.

Match fees for all players participating in senior fixtures have been standardised at £3.00 per game (30 overs or more). This fee includes the cost of the cricket tea. For all members this is a reduction on 2007 charges. There will be no match fees for all senior fixtures of fewer than 30 overs.

Due to the high cost of hiring the facilities at All Saints' School, the charges for winter indoor practice sessions will still apply.

We hope that this explains the changes that have been agreed at the AGM. A summary of the charges for each age category is given overleaf. If you have any questions please don't hesitate to ask members of the committee or one of the coaches.

The following fees were agreed by members at the 2008 AGM

Membership Category	Membership Fee	Cricket Fee	Match Fee
Ordinary	£40	£60	£3 for games of 30 or more overs (to include cost of tea) No match fee for games of fewer than 30 overs.
U17	£25	£60	No match fee for U17 fixtures Match fee will apply for U17 members playing in senior fixtures (at the Ordinary membership rate).
U15	£20	£60	No match fee for U15 or U14 fixtures Match fee will apply for U15 members playing in senior fixtures (at the Ordinary membership rate).
Juniors (U13)	£15	£60	No match fee for U13 or U14 fixtures Match fee will apply for U13 members playing in senior fixtures (at the Ordinary membership rate).
Juniors (U11)	£15	£30	No match fee for U11 or U9 fixtures U11s are not permitted to play in senior fixtures.
Family	£50	£60	According to individual member status.
Associate	£10	n/a	n/a
Patron	£120	n/a	n/a

Notes: Family members pay £60 cricket fee to cover all family members.  
Patrons make a minimum donation of £10 per month.
